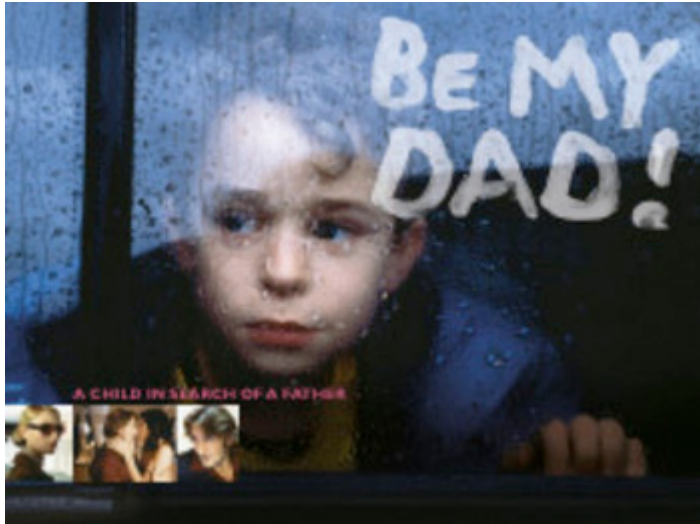


Best Daddy Collection

If only the father were as easy to handle as the baby!

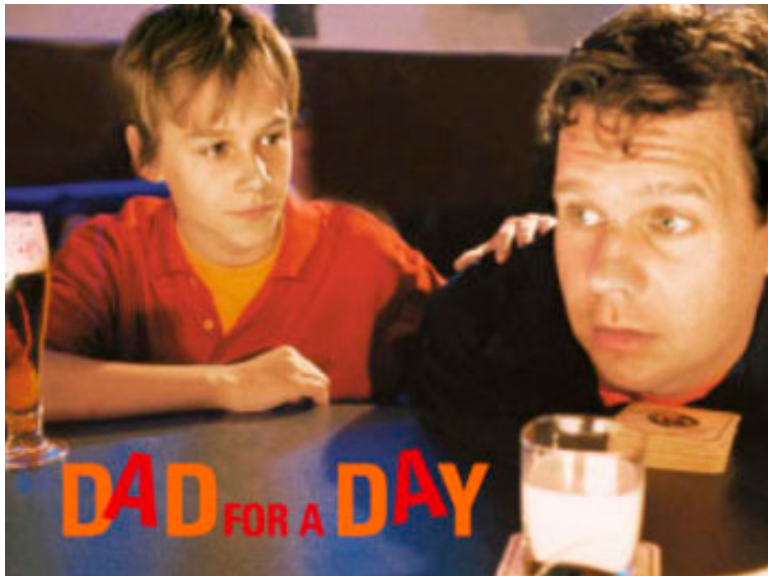
