

THE DIRECTOR

Stefan Ruzowitzky was born in 1961 in Vienna, Austria. Raised in Düsseldorf, Germany, he studied theatre, media, film and history. Since 1987 Stefan worked as a freelance director, writer and editor for television, producing documentaries, comedy and live shows. In the early 90s, he started directing music videos for bands like The Scorpions, No Mercy and Justin Timberlake/NSYNC (nomination "Best Video" / MTV). He directed commercials for clients like Wrigley's, McDonald's, Mastercard and T-Mobile for which he received numerous awards. In 1996 Stefan completed his first feature film Tempo. In 1998 The Inheritors became a festival hit at festivals like Telluride. New York Film Festival and Toronto, winning more than 20 international awards. Anatomy (2000) became the top grossing German genre movie ever. In 2008 The Counterfeiters won the Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film. After the commercially successful family movie Lilly the Witch, Stefan started working in the US, directing Deadfall and co-creating internationally successful series like 8 Days and The Barbarians.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Hinterland is about toxic masculinity. Perg and hundreds of thousands of his comrades return from war, the ultimate place where man can prove himself against man. They have lost this war, they feel shame and anger, they suffer from their "failure". They react to this with blind aggression against others, against themselves.

In these new times after the Great War, nothing feels right and straightforward to men like Perg, everything seems deformed and out of kilter. We have tried to depict the image of an essentially distorted world for Hinterland, a digital version of the silent film classic *The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari*, as it were, in which we worked with expressionistically crooked backdrops.

Hinterland was shot almost exclusively on blue screen. We tried to create an exciting balance between this hard, loud, brutal man's world and the complex soul landscapes of our protagonists with their existential wounds.

THE DIRECTOR

Florian Dietrich was born in Wiesbaden in 1986. After graduating from high school, he worked as assistant director in theatre and studied Media Dramaturgy at the University of Mainz. He produced several theatre and short film projects with inmates at Wiesbaden's juvenile prison. From 2007 he studied directing at the German Film and Television Academy in Berlin and at the film department of Tel Aviv University. His short films GhettoLoveGrief (2011) and Breaking Through (2012) were shown at various international film festivals. *Toubab* is his first feature film.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

The idea for *Toubab* came about while my co-author Arne Dechow and I were devising theatre projects in a youth prison in Wiesbaden. Some of the young prisoners we worked with were facing deportation, despite the fact that they were born in Germany. Until then I had been unaware that it was possible to deport people who had spent their entire lives in Germany. Additionally, with each denial of a secure residence status, their families had been systematically marginalized and criminalized. We spoke to many of those affected about their powerlessness and their desperate struggles. We experienced how displaced the boys felt, when they were deported to places that the German state considered their "homeland".

My main aim with *Toubab* was to counter this perversion of the German right of residence. At the same time, I did not want to focus on the suffering of those affected. The film should celebrate them for their courage, their strength and their creativity in dealing with the authorities.

THE DIRECTOR

Enrique Urbizu is one of the Spanish filmmakers who has most successfully combined audience reach with a personal and defined style. His first feature film is the farce Your Girlfriend is Crazy (1987), followed by the thriller Anything for Bread (1991). In Madrid, he directed two comedies, adaptation from Carmen Rico Godoy's novels: Cómo ser infeliz y disfrutarlo (1994) and Cuernos de mujer (1995). He also adapted a short story by Arturo Pérez-Reverte, Cachito, which led to him to work on the screenplay of the adaptation of *El club Dumas* (Roman Polanski's The Ninth Gate). In 2002, he directed Box 507, a thriller about political corruption and in 2000. Life Marks, a melodrama with a film noir approach. No Rest for the Wicked (2011) is his latest feature film and was awarded with 6 Gova Awards incl. Best Director and Best Film. In 2018, he directed 2 seasons of the series Gigantes (Giants), which premiered in the Official Section of the San Sebastian Film Festival.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

I've always been interested in the crime world. The romantic bandolero iconography - the horse, the wilds - have been part and parcel of Spain for many years. They link to such themes as the illiteracy and injustice of rural Spain. The 19th century was immensely interesting. In 2021, the issues the characters talk about are still very much alive. The film allows us to peek into the past and contemplate where we come from and what happened to explain our state today. It looks like we haven't learned much. As the Plainswoman puts it: "There will never be that (progress) here." I always work from the material, for the material and with the material. The story, the characters, the stage, they dictate. A cabin, a well and the horizon line give few ways to shoot them or where to put your camera. So you have to work instinctively, honestly and with what's in front of you. My "hard drive" is packed with cinematography, but apart from the obvious last shot, I don't work by consciously quoting other films. There's a sense of influence of course: Raoul Walsh, Anthony Mann, Henry Hathaway, Mackendrick's A High Wind in Jamaica and Lang's Moonfleet. But they never translate directly into my frames. I try to work from another place.




