



THE STORY

In the impoverished confines of her parents' home, 17-year-old Marta awaits the return of her fiancé from war. As a single mother, she faces the scorn of her community and once the war is over and Michele doesn't turn back, she finds herself promised to an older farmer. During the village's preparatory course for wives, she forges an unlikely friendship with Lorenzo, the village's openly gay "wedding planner." In the conservative backdrop of rural Southern Italy, Lorenzo introduces her to a hidden community of gays, sparking Marta's courageous journey to challenge societal prejudices. In the first year of women's suffrage in Italy, Marta navigates her evolving role as a woman, breaking barriers and finding her place in a changing world.

THE DIRECTORS

Daniela Porto graduated in Arts, Music, and Performing Arts from the University of Roma Tre in 2003. She started her career in photography at Contrasto agency and later moved to Orisa Produzioni, supervising most of its productions. Her novel, "Il Mio Posto È Qui," was published by Sperling & Kupfer, and its film adaptation is her debut as a director, together with her life partner Cristiano Bortone.

Cristiano Bortone, a graduate of USC and NYU, is the director of the acclaimed drama *Red Like The Sky* (2005) – winner of a David di Donatello Italian Film Award and awards at more than 25 other international festivals – and *Coffee* (2016), the first official co-production between Italy and China, which premiered as a special event at the Venice Days and was nominated for the China Media Awards. He is also a successful and award-winning producer (*Maria, Ihm Schmeckt's Nicht!*, *Marina, The Italian Recipe*).

DIRECTORS' NOTE


The story of *Il mio posto è qui* takes place in the aftermath of World War II. It is a historical moment in which Europe experiences, in a relatively short period of time, enormous social, cultural and political changes. The film recalls this fundamental page of history from a unique and original point of view: that of a single mother in a remote village. Although the film is set in Calabria in the mid-40s, some of its themes remain very up to date. Almost every day we read about cases of feminicide or acts of intolerance. The debate opened by the #MeToo movement has brought to light the issue once more. These topics, which by now should already be assimilated in modern society, are in fact recently even being challenged by new conservative movements making their way through Europe and around the world. With this story, we want to contribute to the reflection of these themes, through emotions and memorable characters.

THE DIRECTOR


Born in Gera, Germany in 1963, Andreas Dresen studied directing at the Konrad Wolf Film University of Babelsberg. His film Grill Point was a worldwide success and won awards including the Silver Bear at the 2002 Berlinale. Cloud 9 (2008), an improvised drama about love and sexuality in older age, won several prizes including the Coup de Coeur jury prize in the 'Un Certain Regard' section at the Cannes Film Festival and the German Film Award Bronze Best Film. In 2011 Stopped on Track won the 'Un Certain Regard' Award at the Cannes Film Festival. In 2019, Gundermann won six German Film Awards, including Best Film. Rabive Kurnaz Vs. George W. Bush, his fourth film in the Berlinale Competition 2022, won the Silver Bear for Best Leading Performance and the Silver Bear for Best Screenplay, as well as three German Film Awards.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

No, no more well-lit resistance drama immersed in sepia, no equipment and costume battle, no orchestral music, no enraptured and enrapturing reconstruction of history. no historicizing distance. The story of Hilde and Hans is touching, precisely because it seems so tangible and normal. The two are very young, filled with a longing for love and, yes, normality. Only times are not like that. Hilde does not join the resistance because of a political mission, but out of decency. She intuitively does what seems right to her. Giving the parents of the missing soldiers news of their survival or helping to transport a radio - that's necessary and normal right now, isn't it? Because of their great love, the two sometimes forget the danger. It's a story of love and death. It starts in the middle, going forward to the abyss and backward to happiness. In the end there is the hope and beauty of a beginning love that extends to the present, because Hans, the little son of the two, luckily survived these dark times. It's been so long. So short.

THE STORY

Radiant neurologist Katerina and Yannis, a former well-respected doctor, are heading off to a deserted seaside resort. Silence spreads in the car as they travel across sandy dunes in a windy autumn, matching the less-than-pleasant occasion: Yannis had been called to identify the victim of a tragic accident at the hospital of the small town. When the local policeman informs them that the victim's vehicle had plunged over the parapet of a stone bridge and leads them to the morgue, Katerina sees her worst suspicions confirmed. Together with Yannis, but also on her own nightly excursions to a mysterious, rustic beach bar called *Arcadia*, they begin to put the pieces of the puzzle together, revealing a haunting story of love, loss, acceptance and letting go.

THE DIRECTOR

Yorgos Zois is a Greek director whose body of work, comprising four shorts and one feature film, has been selected at A-festivals worldwide (Cannes - Semaine de la Critique, Venice - Orizzonti, Rotterdam, Telluride, etc.). His work has been recognized with multiple awards globally, including Best Newcomer Feature Director and Best Short Film from the Hellenic Film Academy. His short film *Out Of Frame* was also nominated as Best Short Film at the European Film Awards. Yorgos Zois served as a member of the official jury for the "Lion of the Future" at the 74th Venice International Film Festival. *Arcadia*, his second feature film, premiered in Official Selection at the Berlinale and went on to screen In Competition in Hong Kong, where Vangelis Mourikis earned the Best Actor Award.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

In mythology, *Arcadia* is referred to as a lost world of idyllic bliss, serving as a cautionary reminder of the transitory nature of life. It is a kind of magical realm, just like the local otherworldly tavern *Arcadia* in the film, where time seems to have stopped.

Arcadia deals with the riskier shores of human loss, ventures into a strange sexual territory and proposes an unusual dimension of the afterlife as the captured memories of the living. Eventually the boundaries between the material and spiritual world become blurred and no one can easily tell the difference.

A dreamlike love story of saying goodbye.

Joseph Goebbels, the Minister of Propaganda, accompanies Hitler during the seven years from the "Anschluss" of Austria in March 1938 to the murder and suicide in the Führerbunker in May 1945. While Hitler is at the height of his power, Goebbels is the creator of the pictures of the flag waving crowds and of the anti-Semitic films "Jud Süß" and "Der ewige Jude", that prepare the people for the mass murder of the Jews. After the defeat at Stalingrad and the situation becoming increasingly hopeless in late 1944, Goebbels plans the most radical propaganda act, his last staging, with Hitler's suicide, the murder of his family and his own suicide.

THE DIRECTOR

Joachim A. Lang, Prof. Dr. is an author and director. He studied German and history at the universities of Heidelberg and Stuttgart. In his early days, he produced documentaries and features and directed television programs, shows and films. In 2013, he realized the German Television Award-winning film *George*. In 2018, he presented *Mack the Knife - Brecht's Threepenny Film*, one of the most important German-language films of the year. Lang's work has been awarded numerous film and television prizes, including the German French Journalism Prize, Bavarian Television Prize, Eurovisioni, German Television Prize, World Gold Medal at the New York Film Festival and the Special Golden Prague Award.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

About 80 years ago, the world witnessed the biggest crimes in human history: the Holocaust and World War II. I was born 14 years after the fall of the Nazi regime, and all my life, I have been grappling with the question of how the perpetrators succeeded in committing such unimaginable atrocities. To find answers, I believe that we must examine the perspective of the perpetrators and delve into their apparatus of power. This is breaking taboos, but it is indispensable because it helps us to tear the masks off their faces and make the mechanisms of demagogy transparent. In doing so we can also unmask and disarm the agitators of the present. All the dialogues in my film are based on actual quotations. The perpetrators spoke in this manner or very similarly. They were able to execute their murderous plans with the help of countless Germans who followed them. Today, we are again witnessing the rise of populists, right-wing extremists, and anti-Semitic acts of violence. With my film, I want to help ensure that what happened never happens again.



THE STORY

THE DIRECTOR

Nick Hamm is a BAFTA award-winning director and producer who began his career as resident director for the Royal Shakespeare Company. He has directed highly successful feature films for Miramax, Film 4, Pathé and Lionsgate. His track records include *Driven*, which was selected as the closing film at the Venice Film Festival 2018 and released by Universal, *Gigi & Nate* (2022), the Netflix series *White Lines* (2020) and *The Journey*, starring Timothy Spall and Colm Meaney and which premiered at the Venice and Toronto Film Festivals in 2016.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Although it takes place in 14th Century Europe, it has a relevance that is strikingly contemporary. It grapples with the age-old themes of oppression and political freedom and details the burgeoning power of a native resistance movement. William Tell is a moral man, a family man, whose guiding principle is truth. The script is political but overridingly emotional. William Tell's initial pacifism and discomfort with the idea of war is challenged when his son's life is directly threatened and Tell is forced to shoot an apple from his head. This scene is famous around the world and forms the cornerstone of the piece.

A captivating insight into the private estate of Leni Riefenstahl, who became world-famous with her Nazi propaganda film *Triumph of the Will* but kept denying any closer ties to the regime.

THE STORY

Andres Veiel uncovers an estate of 700 boxes of film, letters and documents that Leni Riefenstahl had left behind after her death in 2003: Starting with Leni Riefenstahl's beginnings as a celebrated actress in the 1930s, the film delineates how her initial encounters with Hitler and Goebbels propelled her to become the Reich's preeminent filmmaker. Her propaganda film "Triumph of the Will" about the 1934 Nazi Party rally in Nuremberg and "Olympia", about the 1936 Summer Olympics in Berlin are world-famous works, deriving from her close, multi-year collaboration with the party's leaders. Hitherto unseen private films, personal photos and intimate documents combined with Video recordings of Riefenstahl's memorable appearances on German and international TV-shows from the 1960s until her death in 2003 show an artist endeavoring to disassociate the striking aesthetics she crafted from the ideology of the Nazis. Andres Veiel lets us investigate ourselves her lies, incantations and slander, elevating the discourse to a universal and timeless inquiry of self-portrayal and external perception within the media.


