When I read Joachim Meyerhoff's autobiographic novel the first time a few years ago, I was surprised. I saw so much in there of how I view life and people, with love and tough love, at the same time, as well as humor, even in the darkest moments. The novel seemed like a friend to me, which I had to turn into a movie - incredibly funny and terribly sad, constantly going back and forth. 

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

I had just turned two years old when the first activists sat down and blocked the construction road in the summer of 1979. As I started researching and meeting activists, historians, and other people who played a part, a range of stories appeared. But there was one story that cried out to be told: the story of the Norwegian government's continued, brutal abuse of the Sámi. When I met Jorunn Eikjok and Synnøve Persen, who risked their lives in a hunger strike in front of the Norwegian Parliament, my heart started pounding and tears welled up. For them, the Alta-case was not just about the continued existence of the river, but about the continued existence of an entire people.

The Norwegianisation has been so effective that almost nobody wanted to admit they were Sámi, especially along the coast of Finnmark where the confrontations between the Norwegians and the Sámi were particularly bad. Now I find myself dealing with my own Sámi identity issues, attempting to fix a wound that can never really be healed.



DIRECTOR'S NOTE

We shot this film in just one week, eager to come together creatively. After months of pandemic isolation, we all craved for adventures and distractions. Although they don't suffer materially, they fear inadequacy in a successbased society. All of them are unhappy and lonely in their own way — yet they desperately want to appear cheerful and strong. For me, this divergence between facade and emotion provides a lot of tragicomic potential for conflicts and awkwardness. I am interested in portraying characters with hopes and self-delusions, who try to save face but eventually lose their composure. The roles were closely developed and explored in collaboration with the actors, who were then let loose in improvisational rehearsals. In doing so, I wanted to encourage their creativity and playfulness within a precise narrative structure. 

Author Clemens Mever and I wanted try a new form of filmic narrative with this episodic film: Three stories which are only loosely connected. Three stories about love, about longing for intimacy and comfort. About the impossibility of fulfilling that need, or for just one magic, fleeting moment. Each episode is different, but connected. The connections of the characters keep dissolving, as if they kept slipping from the characters' hands. As if the light in one of those illuminated windows, which promised refuge and comfort for a moment, had been switched off. A series of seeming random encounters illuminate the characters in a tragic and beautiful dignity. For me, *Dark Satellites* is the conclusion of a trilogy with Herbert and In The Aisles. Who knows what's next.

Will there even be movies any more?
