THE DIRECTOR

Michael Bully Herbig is a German director, actor, author, and producer. He collected numerous film awards and is one of Germany's most successful directors, attracting more than 30 million viewers to movie theaters within ten years.



THE DIRECTOR

Aelrun Goette is an award-winning and versatile writer and director. She studied directing at the Film University in Babelsberg, where she made her first documentary film *Ohne Bewährung – Psychogramm einer Mörderin*, about a fifteen-year-old murderer. The film, which emerged from her more than six years of volunteer work as a correctional assistant in the Plötzensee women's prison, won the Robert Geisendörfer Prize. In the GDR, I was arrested for wearing a badge. I couldn't graduate from high school and was placed under surveillance. At the same time, I worked with the most amazing photographers, went to parties, and fled over rooftops from the police.

Glamour, fashion, and the underground in a dictatorship is the world in which I ask the universal questions for today: how can we walk tall through life and where do we find the freedom that our hearts yearn for? Where does personal fulfillment stop and where does betrayal begin? And what to do with all this longing and irrepressible lust for life?

In A Land That No Longer Exists is a further step in my work to date and already an important milestone for me as a filmmaker.





"You are the person you are because of the body you have," says one of the characters in *Skin Deep*. But what does this mean in times of fluid identities? Can our body adapt to the development of our personality? Or is it an unchangeable, insurmountable limit to which we must adapt? What happens when body and mind are out of harmony? And how utterly complex does it become when such disharmony affects not one but two two-parted beings living together as a couple?

At the beginning of *Skin Deep* was my wish to find a cinematic translation for what happens when a relationship undergoes a major change. 

THE DIRECTOR

Kilian Riedhof, born in 1971 in Jugenheim an der Bergstraße, started his career as a director and screenwriter at the Hamburg Media School, before receiving not only critical accolades but also numerous awards – including the Grimme Award and the German Television Award – for the television drama *Homevideo*. In 2018, he filmed the hostage drama *54 Hours*, which was based on real events, as a two-part television series, which also became a major international success. DIRECTOR'S NOTE

I read the book in one go and was moved as rarely before. The next day I told my co-authors about the story. First I was going to read them a few paragraphs, and ended up reading the whole book. They had tears in their eyes. That's when we knew we had to do this.

Thankfully, Antoine Leiris agreed to the film. He liked our approach and our passion for his story. And he thought it was a good idea that we make the film – that is, Germans who were not directly at the epicenter of the events, but who can view everything from a good distance.

However, for me films are emotional, in the best case physical experiences. What do we learn here? Perhaps that our love for each other is ultimately stronger than the hatred in our world. Even if the forces of hatred can inflict terrible wounds, as we see right now. "My son and myself, we are stronger than all the armies of the world," Antoine writes in his post. This is our hope. As fragile as it is vivid.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

America touches themes from my own life, but that is not why I fought to make it, on the contrary. I made this film to share through the characters what I see as universal human values: compassion, friendship and forgiveness. Without protagonists and antagonists, without judgement, but with the presence of secrets and mystery, I wanted to give a voice to the characters of the film, each from their own perspective, while exploring the world of water, plants and flowers. Making this film often felt like writing a novel, inspired by old cinema, the one of the 60s and 70s.

We shot the film in lockdown in Tel Aviv and Berlin, while the world around us was fighting the Covid crisis. When one of the locations turned out to be by chance (or was it?) the house in which my mother grew up, it felt like the hand of destiny pointed to me and my team the way to tell this story, like it is for Eli, Iris and Yotam. This film is their story, their memories and their heritage - it is no longer my own.







DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Journey to Yourland tells the story of ten-year-old Riki, who dives into a big adventure, taking place in two different worlds: "Yourland" is a fantasy world, a place, where everything is possible and where dreams and crazy ideas come true. There are giant robots and magical creatures, but it is also a site of cruel battles. In Yourland, Riki will encounter his own feelings, personified by other characters, and cope with them. The other world is Riki's real world - cold, grey, and shrouded in difficult family problems, inspired by a concrete housing estate built in Bratislava, but you can find similar places all over the world. Time will show Riki though that all the real problems can be solved if we choose the right path. From the beginning, I wanted to preserve the "human touch" in the visual part of the film. That's why I decided to use a puppet stopmotion look and feel for the 3D assets and for animation.






