



THE FORGER

THE STORY

21-year-old Cioma Schönhaus won't let anyone take away his zest for life, especially not the Nazis. He wants to discover life, but has the misfortune of living as a Jewish person in Berlin in the 1940s. Since the best hiding spots are in plain sight, Cioma decides to go out into the light to escape deportation. Using the identity of a marine officer he created for himself, he throws himself into the city's nightlife and even finds a fragile hope for love during the darkest moments of the war. Throughout the day he forges IDs with just a brush, some ink and a steady hand - and saves the lives of many others. His talent puts him in more and more danger, though, and at some point Cioma's only hope to survive is a last forged ID – with his own name on it.



THE DIRECTOR

Maggie Peren is an award-winning writer and director born in Heidelberg, Germany. After studying literature and psychology in Munich, she started writing her first screenplay Forget America when she was twenty-four years old. In 2003, she received the German Film Award for Before the Fall, followed by numerous screenplays for which she won national and international awards. In 2011 she presented her second directorial work, The color of the ocean. The refugee drama celebrated its premiere in Toronto and was awarded several prizes worldwide. The thriller short film Nocebo (2014) won the student Oscar for best foreign film.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Cioma Schönhaus's story is the story of a person who rebels against stigmatization.

The regime of terror is present, but we do not offer the Nazis a platform. We see them through Cioma's eyes as we see everything through his eyes.

The most difficult thing for me as a director was to do justice to the lightness of the novel and at the same time tell how people hate Jews as a matter of course, thinking that they are friendly and nice after all. It was important to me to raise awareness that racism doesn't come out of nowhere. The roots go deep into our society and Cioma's story in its enormous lightness has nevertheless - or just because of it - the power to trace the depth of the roots.

THE STORY

Colombia, May 1960, just a few days after the abduction of the Nazi criminal Adolf Eichmann by Mossad agents in Argentina.

Polsky, a lonely and grumpy Holocaust survivor, lives in the remote Colombian countryside. He spends his days playing chess and tending his beloved rose bushes. One day, when a mysterious old German man moves in next-door, he suspects that his new neighbor is... Adolf Hitler. Since nobody believes him, he embarks on a detective mission to find the evidence. But, in order to gather evidence, he will need to be closer to his neighbor than he would like. So close that the two could almost become friends.

THE DIRECTOR

Leon Prudovsky was born in St.-Petersburg, Russia in 1978, and immigrated to Israel at the age of 13. Holding a BFA from The Steve Tisch School of Film and Television (Tel Aviv University), he co-wrote/wrote and directed 3 TV series, 2 feature films, and many short and medium length films, awarded in dozens of film events, such as Student Academy Awards™, Venice Film Festival, Beijing Film Academy, Seoul Drama Awards, Jerusalem and Haifa FF, Sao-Paolo FF, Clermont-Ferrand and Montpellier FF and others. Leon writes his own scripts, equally directs other projects and has served as a script consultant and artistic adviser in different Film Funds and private production companies for years. His last feature My Neighbor Adolf will screen in the beginning of 2022. Leon is based in Tel Aviv and Paris and speaks fluent Hebrew, Russian, English, French and Spanish.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

My grandmother was a bitter, short-tempered woman. She rarely laughed, she was constantly tense, always waiting for the next blow. Like many Holocaust survivors, she could never recover from the trauma, reconcile with the loss, or get over her enmity towards German. In My Neighbor Adolf, I tried to tell sort of a Hasidic parable, with an ironic and tragic offbeat humor, so typical for the pre-Holocaust Jewish world. A parable, which walks the fine line between grief and ridicule, realism and absurdity, clever delicacy and grotesque bluntness. A parable, which explores the nature of animosity and takes the spectator into an experience of getting involved emotionally with the enemy, an object of sheer hatred. What might happen if one gets to know one's worst enemy? If one starts seeing the humanity in him, even befriends him. Is hatred based on trauma stronger than the need for a friend? Is there a place for reconciliation? These questions are eternal and universal for any kind of hatred, any conflict, any nation, and any time and I believe they are urgent today more than ever.





HUI BUH AND THE WITCH'S CASTLE

THE STORY

For over 500 years now, the castle ghost Hui Buh has been stirring things up at Castle Burgeck. His friend and owner of the castle, King Julius is not the only one who finds Hui Buh's poor attempts at scary hauntings terribly annoying. The chaotic atmosphere at the castle reaches an all-time high when the young witch Ophelia appears at the castle gates out of nowhere, claiming to be Hui Buh's long lost niece. Ophelia is in possession of the Necronomicon, an ancient book of spells that is as evil as it is powerful. Hui Buh, realizing the possibilities that the book would open up for him, is dying to get his hands on the book. But there is someone else who would like to take possession of the book: The evil and unconscionable witch Erla. Erla has kidnapped Hui Buh's sister, a good witch, and also tries to capture Ophelia. Thus, Hui Buh embarks on a dangerous adventure to save his family. This leads him all the way into the eerie witch's forest, where he has to make a terribly difficult choice.

THE DIRECTOR

Sebastian Niemann was born on June 21, 1968 in Lüneburg, Germany. He is a director and writer, known for Jack the Ripper (2016), Hui Buh-Das Schlossgespenst (2006) and 7 Days to Live (2000).

Niemann belongs to the group of German directors that are specialized in genre filmmaking. Their passion and professionalism are palpable in both their theatrical and tv work. Niemann studied at Hochschule für Fernsehen und Film in Munich. In 1994, his student short film *Verfolger* won the Special Jury Award at the International Festival of Fantasy, Horror & Science Fiction in Brussels. His breakthrough came with the big screen adaptation of the audiobook series *Hui Buh - Das Schlossgespenst* in 2006. It turned into one of the most successful German films of the year and an international sales hit.

Since the mystery thriller *Birkenbrennen* in 1999, Niemann has exclusively worked with producer Christian Becker and his company Rat Pack Filmproduktion, who produced amongst others the internationally acclaimed The Wave, the family entertainment hit *Vicky the Viking* and recent NETFLIX smash hit *Blood Red Sky*. For *Hui Buh and the Witch's Castle*, Niemann and Becker have teamed up again, bound for another success.



THE DIRECTOR

Director Maurice Trouwborst graduated at the Utrecht University of the Arts in 2006. His graduation film Jef won three audience awards at national festivals. After graduation, he directed the TV drama Urfeld and the Christmas-viral A Merry Hunt. In 2015 he directed the television drama Dames 4. Then he directed the sci-fi youth series Zenith, winning the Cinekid Jury Award in 2018 and nominated for a Rockie Award at BANFF. The series was sold to Arte and broadcasted in Germany and France. More recently he has been showrunner and director on the successful youth series *Floor* Rules, which is broadcasted in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Norway, Denmark, Belgium and France. The series won both jury and audience awards at Cinekid and it won the International Emmy Kids Award for best series in 2020. His first feature film Captain Nova opened the 35th Cinekid Festival, where it won the jury awards for Best Children's Film and Best Dutch Children's film, as well as the audience award for Best Children's film.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Since I was a teen I dreamed of making a movie for the big screen. And with this film my dream became reality. Unfortunately, global warming is not a dream unlikely to happen. It is a real nightmare coming our way. Captain Nova debates our current climate-crisis in a thrilling sci-fi adventure that will make you sit on the edge of your seat. It is a story about the friendship between a neglected boy and a mysterious girl from the future. The story unravels her secret mission to save the future world in an exciting ride filled with spectacular action, witty dialogue and funny jokes.

Our goal is to bring all people together to discuss their own responsibility in this urgent matter without finger pointing to others. Although the movie will appeal to the entire family it will especially inspire and motivate children to let their voices be heard - in a call to ensure their own future. As they will be the ones confronted with the consequences of global warming the most.

THE DIRECTOR

Lena Stahl started her career in Scandinavia. She studied at the European Film College in Denmark followed by various jobs in the film and TV industry in Sweden, Denmark and Germany. In 2005 she started studying direction and screenwriting at the University of Television and Film (HFF) in Munich. Her graduation film *Alle Tage Meines Lebens* was nominated for the prestigious Max Ophüls Award and was screened at numerous international film festivals. After winning the Pro7/Sat1 Mainstream Award for her screenplay *Blackout*, she focused primarily on screenwriting. She has written various screenplays for film and television, collaborating with many different production companies, including X Filme (*Babylon Berlin*), akzentefilm (*The Silent Revolution*) and Warner Bros. Germany. *My Son* is her feature film debut as a writer/director. Lena Stahl lives in Berlin with actor Leopold Hornung and their two children.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

With My Son I wanted to explore the relationship between a mother and her grown-up son to the core. The central theme being, how fear can hold us back in our longing to spread our wings. But isn't fear always our worst enemy? We can be so close to each other; just to become estranged only minutes later. What can we ever know of each other as individuals and as a family? Both as a daughter and a mother I wonder, why is it so difficult to let go of each other and meet again as equals.



In 2017 their film Ammore e Malavita was presented at Venice Film Festival. The film won many awards such as the David di Donatello Award for Best Picture. Among others, the Manetti Bros. directed the cult television series L'Ispettore Coliandro and also produced and shot web-series as well as music videos.



THE STORY
